Fall Cleanup

One of the advantages of living in our HOA is that the HOA dues pay for a fall and spring cleanups. It is an opportunity to get rid of those items that have been piling up in your home, garage, and yard. Lakewood also hosts a fall and spring cleanup, but you may have to wait in line for a while. Your HOA pays to have a cleanup so you can get rid of your unwanted trash/items close to home and not wait in line.

This year our Fall clean up was on October 29th. These are free to those who have paid their dues and if you have not paid your dues, you can at the event with an additional \$10 fee. You are not allowed to dump appliances, paint, or anything with oils or fuel and moderate size furniture is acceptable. This winter is a great time to start planning what will need to be thrown out and disposed of come spring. The date for the spring cleanup is to be announced.

Cleanup Recycling

One of our members, Brian Sullivan has been at the past few cleanups collecting metals and other recyclables. The HOA's goal is to decrease the weight of collected trash in order to reduce the HOA's cost as well as our environmental impact. During the past two cleanups, with your support, Brain was able to divert 2,500lbs of metals from ending up in the landfill.

In addition, Brain broke down the recovered items to increase their value before selling them to local metal and e-waste recycling companies. The monies were donated to the Pierce Conservation District and the Nisqually Land Trust to purchase native plants for use in habitat restoration projects. Thank you for taking advantage of this HOA service.


Membership, Covenants & Yearly Dues

Membership in the Oakbrook, 7th Addition HOA is not voluntary and dues are require in accordance with the HOA Articles of Incorporation and the By-laws, which are on file with Pierce County and on the HOA website: http://oakbrook7th.com/

Article V of the Articles of Incorporation, says, "Every person or entity who is a record owner ... be a member of the Association. Such membership shall commence, exist and continue simply by virtue of such ownership...

Article X of the By-laws specifies that annual dues, which were originally set for \$20, but since 1978 have been increased to only \$30.00 "Dues are payable upon joining the Association and annually after 1 Jan".
